

Selection Criteria

In order to discriminate and measure the performance of National Teachers' Day Award aspirants, the Award Selection Committee of National Foundation for Entrepreneurship Development (NFED) has devised selection criteria and star status. The national award selection process includes scrutinizing of nomination form along with the required supportive documents in accordance with fulfilling the mandatory requirements, which is followed by the recommendations of award juries to the selection committee in adherence to stratification guidelines with regard to award categories and finally assigning the star status to the awardee. There will be a sentence describing the Award Status of all the Awardees in accordance with their selection to NFED's 12th National Teachers' Day Awards 2021.

The Star Categories will be based on the following:

 - c) Patent (s) / Innovation (s) / Project (s) / Event (s)
 - d) Membership (s) in Advisory Board (s), Editorial Board (s) in Refereed International / National Journal Editorial Board (s)
 - e) Course & Curriculum Development Activities
 - f) Memberships in Professional (Organizational / Institutional / Professional) Bodies
 - g) Conference (s), Seminar (s), Workshop (s) organized
 - h) Socio-Economic Sustenance / Developmental Activities (Magazine / Newspaper Editorial / Reporting Services)
